FINAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT IN FAVOR OF CREDITOR MYRA REED
(DOC. 10)

This cause having come before the Court for hearing on the Motion for Summary Judgment of Creditor Myra Reed (Doc. 10) and Debtor's Amended Response in opposition to same (Doc. 19), and the Court having reviewed the matter, having entered its Order (Doc. 42) Granting Creditor Myra Reed's Motion, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

ORDERED that Final Summary Judgment is entered in favor of Creditor Myra Reed and against Debtor, as follows:

1. As to the amounts owed to Myra Reed by Debtor concerning past due child support and/or alimony, those amounts are non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 523(a)(5).
2. As to the amounts owed to Myra Reed by Debtor concerning the Supplemental Final Judgment (a/k/a the "Equalizer Judgment"), those amounts are non-dischargeable pursuant to 11

U.S.C. Section 523(a)(15).

3. As to the amounts owed to Myra Reed by Debtor concerning the Annabella's real estate development contribution claim, those amounts are non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 523(a)(15).
